GETTING STARTED

BREAKING CHAD

Chad has played in 34 games with 32 starts in two seasons at UofL. Her 55 goals this season rank 13th in the nation and sixth in ACC. Her 1.5 free position goals per game rank sixth in the country. For her career, she has 98 goals in a Louisville uniform, which ranks 10th all-time, and her 2.88 goals per game in two seasons at Louisville, rank third all-time in program history. In her four years combined at Canisius and Louisville, she has played in 74 games with 189 goals and 213 points. She has scored a hat trick in seven of the Cards' last 11 games and has 42 goals in that stretch. She has 10 hat tricks on the season.

BIRCH CLIMBS THE ACC STANDINGS

Freshman Maddie Birch ranks second in the ACC with 1.59 caused turnovers per game. She has tallied 27 through 17 contests, while also collecting 2.12 ground balls per game, which ranks sixth in the conference standings.

APPROACHING MILESTONES

Tessa Chad is two goals away from 100 in her two years at UofL. With 11 points vs. OSU, she eclipsed 200 points (213) for her four-year career and surpassed 100 (111) in her two years at UofL. With six draw controls vs. UNC, Alex McNicholas surpassed (106) in her career. Brenna Shanahan's three ground balls at Virginia gave her 100 (101) for her four-year career.

RANKED VS. UNRANKED

UofL is 5-4 against unranked teams and 0-8 against ranked teams.

IN THE ACC TOURNAMENT

UofL is seeking its first ever win in the ACC Tournament. This marks second straight season they meet BC in first round. 2015 - vs. Duke (L, 14-7); 2016 - vs. ND (L, 12-10); 2017 - vs. UVA (L, 13-12); 2018 - vs. BC (L, 19-6)

ABOUT THE EAGLES

Boston College (17-0) enters Wednesday's matchup as the top-ranked team in the nation with 10 wins against ranked opponents this season. The Eagles are averaging 17.6 goals per game with an average margin of victory of 7.8 goals. Senior attacker Sam Apuzzo leads the Eagles' offense with 71 goals and 25 assists for 96 points on the season. Fellow attacker Kenzie Kent follows just behind with 36 goals and a team-high 58 assists for 94 points. Apuzzo also leads Boston College in ground balls (28), caused turnovers (22) and draw controls (127). In goal, sophomore Abbey Ngai has started 12 contests for the Eagles and has tallied 119 saves with a save percentage of .506. As a team, Boston College was tabbed as the conference favorite in the ACC Preseason Coaches Poll. Five Eagles were named to the All-ACC Preseason Team, including Apuzzo, Kent, senior midfielder Dempsey Arsenault, senior defender Elizabeth Miller and senior goalkeeper Lauren Daly.

■ **Series History** - The Cardinals are 1-5 all-time against the Eagles, including a 0-3 record on the road. Just four days ago in Boston, Louisville fell 19-6 to conclude regular season play. Last year, they met in the first round of the ACC Tournament with the Cardinals falling 19-6.

QUICK HITTERS

■ Despite leading the team with 56 goals and eight times leading the Cards in goals in a game, Tessa Chad scored the first goal of the game for just the second time this season against Ohio State.

■ Alex McNicholas has scored the first goal eight times this season, including the last two games. She has 23 goals on the season.

■ Louisville is 5-0 when winning the draw control battle.

■ Louisville is 3-2 when they score first, 2-10 when their opponent scores first.

■ Alex McNicholas had five caused turnovers at BC on Saturday, which tied Maddie Birch's five vs. Mercer for the most in a game this season.

■ Louisville had a season-low five draw controls vs. BC and were beaten 21-5 on the draw. The previous low was six at Notre Dame, vs. Syracuse and vs. Delaware.

■ Boston College's 40 shots on Saturday were the most allowed by UofL this year, the previous high was 36 at Northwestern.

CHAD BREAKS RECORD FOR GOALS IN A GAME...AGAIN

Tessa Chad scored nine goals and tallied two assists, setting a program record for points and tying her own record for goals in a single game, to lift the Cards past Ohio State 19-7. She also netted nine goals against Duquesne earlier this year. She surpassed the previous mark of eight goals, which was set by Bergen Foley vs. UC Davis on May 1, 2009.

SCORING STREAK

Louisville trailed 9-3 at Virginia, but scored four straight and outscored the Cavaliers 9-7 the rest of the way. Trailing 4-2, Louisville reeled off 11 straight goals to take a 13-4 lead against Ohio State. The Buckeyes scored with 23:26 left in the first and did not score again until 21:40 in the second. They recorded 14 straight goals vs. Mercer to open a 14-0 lead.

SEEKING AN ACC WIN

Louisville is seeking its first ACC win since defeating Syracuse 9-8 at UofL Lacrosse Stadium on April 22, 2017. Their last ACC road win was a 13-12 overtime win at Virginia Tech on April 1, 2017.

TAKING CARE OF THE BALL

The Cardinals have turned the ball over less than their opponent in 10 of their 17 contests with a team-low 11 turnovers in their 17-16 loss to Virginia Tech. They had 15 turnovers in their previous three games prior to committing 20 at BC.

ON THE DRAW

In their 23-13 win over Duquesne, the Cardinals tallied 23 draw controls, which marked the third-highest total in program history. Caroline Blalock led the way for Louisville with six, followed by Paige Richbourg with five.

23 GOALS TIES PROGRAM RECORD

Louisville recorded 23 goals in the 23-13 win over Duquesne. It tied the program record set on April 6, 2014 vs. Cincinnati (W, 23-2) and on March 9, 2013 vs. Presbyterian (W, 23-1).

OVERTIME GAMES

The Cardinals have played two overtime games this season after playing none in 2018. Louisville fell 9-8 to Vanderbilt in OT on Feb. 27 and 11-10 in double OT to No. 15 Duke on March 10.

ENDING THE SKID

The Cardinals snapped an 11-game losing streak with their 20-2 win over Mercer. It marked their first victory since winning at Mercer (21-14) on March 14, 2018.

HEAD COACH SCOTT TEETER

Scott Teeter is in his second year as head coach of the University of Louisville women's lacrosse team. In 16 years, he has compiled a 156-143 career record.

Prior to coming to Louisville, he served as head coach at Canisius for 15 years (2003-2017; 145-120). Upon his arrival in Buffalo, he took the reins of a team that had won just 11 games in the program's first seven seasons. Under his guidance, he changed the culture of the program and was named MAAC Coach of the Year in just his third season after leading the Griffs to an eight-win improvement in 2005.

In 2011, Canisius won a school-record 14 games and capped the successful campaign with the program's first MAAC Tournament title. The Griffs added postseason championships in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016 and 2017. In the run from 2011-14, the team became the first school in MAAC history to win four straight conference titles. Canisius also claimed regular-season crowns in 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017 after sweeping through conference foes without a loss.

He was named the league's coach of the year again in 2015, 2016 and 2017, after becoming the first three teams in MAAC history to post a perfect 8-0 regular-season record.

He left Canisius as the winningest coach in MAAC history.

Teeter has also served as head coach of the Canadian Under-19 National Team since 2009. He guided the team to a bronze-medal showing during the 2011 championship in Hannover, Germany, before earning the country's first women's field lacrosse title.
