#### LOOKING TO END THE SKID

With losses in their first three games this season and their final eight last year, the Cardinals are looking to end an 11-game losing streak.

#### A GAME OF RUNS

After falling behind 15-4 at the half in their season opener against No. 7 Northwestern, the Cardinals reeled off five straight goals and ultimately won the second half by a margin of 7-6. Despite the strong second half performance, the Cards fell to the Wildcats 21-11. Against Marquette, Louisville went on yet another 5-0 run in under 10 minutes to even the score at 7-7 with 2:38 left in the first half. However, the Golden Eagles tallied two straight goals to end the half with a 9-7 lead that they would never relinquish, despite a stretch of three unanswered goals by the Cardinals in the second half.

#### CAROLINE BLALOCK NAMED ALL-ACC SECOND TEAM

Caroline Blalock was named All-ACC Second Team a year ago. She was joined by senior Emily Howell, which marked the third consecutive season that at least two UofL players have earned All-ACC honors. Blalock led the Cards in seven statistical categories, including goals with 43 and hat tricks with nine. She ranked third in the league in shots with 6.53 per game, and just outside top ten in goals per game with 2.53 and points per game with 3.24. She also ranked fourth with 1.41 caused turnovers per game and sixth with 2.41 ground balls per game. She was voted ILWomen National Rookie of the Week following her four-goal performance against Virginia. In the game against UVA, she finished with four goals, two ground balls and two draw controls.

#### **ABOUT THE BEARS**

Mercer (0-2) opened their season with a 13-6 loss to Oregon on the road before falling to UC Davis 16-13 in Jacksonville, Fla. just over one week later. Two Bears have recorded hat tricks so far this season, including Kelly Hagerty with three goals against Oregon and Hailey Rhatigan with four against UC Davis. The pair leads Mercer with five goals apiece through two games. In goal, Iseabal Cryne has tallied 23 saves for a save percentage of .442. Last season, the Bears earned their first-ever NCAA Tournament berth by winning the inaugural Southern Conference Championship. Returners Audrey Robertson and Michaela Lucas were named to the preseason all-conference team after earning All-SoCon First and Second Team honors a year ago.

■ Series History - UofL is 1-0 all-time against Mercer and has yet to play the Bears at UofL Lacrosse Stadium. The last meeting was a 21-14 win for Louisville in Macon, Ga. on March 14, 2018.

#### LAST YEAR AGAINST THE BEARS

Last season at Mercer, the Cardinals fell behind 7-1 with just over 18 minutes left in the first half. The Cards then went on a 13-0 scoring run that lasted until the 26:35 mark in the second half. Tessa Chad and Caroline Blalock each recorded hat tricks, igniting the Cards' to a 21-14 win over the Bears. The 21-goal performance tied for the third most ever scored by a Cardinals team.

#### **TOUGH LOSS**

The 18-2 defeat at Denver on Saturday marked the lopsided defeat in program history.

#### TWO OF A KIND

Caroline Blalock and Tessa Chad led the attack for the Cards last season. They combined to score 85 goals. Blalock recorded hat tricks in more than half of the Cards' 17 games with nine, while Chad logged eight. In the Cardinals first two games, Chad picked up right where she left off last season, recording three goals against Northwestern and Marquette for her ninth and 10th career hat tricks.

#### **HAT TRICKS**

The Cardinals tallied a total of 30 hat tricks last season coming from seven different players (C. Blalock 9, Chad 8, Hoover 4, Balog 3, Wood 3, Hall 2, McNicholas 1). Tessa Chad recorded her ninth and 10th hat trick as a Cardinal against Northwestern and Marquette last weekend with a team-high three goals in each contest. Ally Hall added the third hat trick of her career against Marquette.

#### ON THE BALL

Lexie Ball started every game at goalie for the Cards last season. She had a career-high 14 saves vs. Syracuse. Her previous career-high was 11 saves three times, against Mercer, Boston College, and Brown. Against Butler, she recorded a save percentage of .692 and helped hold the Bulldogs to just four goals.

#### THE TEETER ERA

Head coach Scott Teeter came to Louisville a season ago after compiling a 145-120 record in 15 seasons at Canisius. He is just the second head coach in the history of the Louisville lacrosse program. In his first season at UofL, the Cardinals went 6-11 and he now owns a 151-134 career record.

#### SISTER SISTER

Sisters Caroline Blalock and Sarah Blalock combined for 51 goals, 15 assists, 66 points, 55 ground balls, and 53 draw controls a year ago. The Blalock sisters each tallied two goals and two draw controls in the season opener against Northwestern. Sarah led the Cards with three draw controls, while Caroline collected two. Against Marquette, the duo notched a goal and an assist a piece for two points, while also securing two draw controls.

#### HEAD COACH SCOTT TEETER

Scott Teeter is in his second year as head coach of the University of Louisville women's lacrosse team. In 16 years, he has compiled a 151-134 career record

Prior to coming to Louisville, he served as head coach at Canisius for 15 years (2003-2017; 145-120). Upon his arrival in Buffalo, he took the reins of a team that had won just 11 games in the program's first seven seasons. Under his guidance,



he changed the culture of the program and was named MAAC Coach of the Year in just his third season after leading the Griffs to an eight-win improvement in 2005.

In 2011, Canisius won a school-record 14 games and capped the successful campaign with the program's first MAAC Tournament title. The Griffs added postseason championships in 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016 and 2017. In the run from 2011-14, the team became the first school in MAAC history to win four straight conference titles. Canisius also claimed regular-season crowns in 2013, 2015, 2016 and 2017 after sweeping through conference foes without a loss.

He was named the league's coach of the year again in 2015, 2016 and 2017, after becoming the first three teams in MAAC history to post a perfect 8-0 regular-season record.

He left Canisius as the winningest coach in MAAC history.

Teeter has also served as head coach of the Canadian Under-19 National Team since 2009. He guided the team to a bronze-medal showing during the 2011 championship in Hannover, Germany, before
